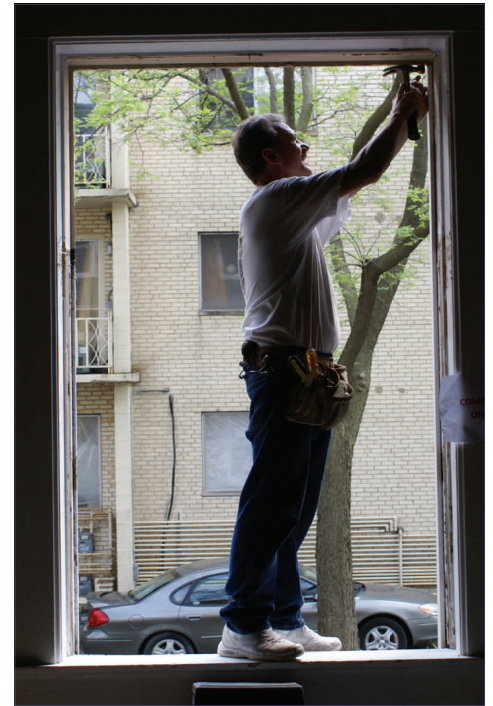

DID YOU KNOW...

According to the Volunteers of America (2011), on any given night, 150,000 veterans (1 in 3 homeless) are homeless. In Illinois alone, 1,000 vets sleep on the streets or in shelters each night. Approximately, 90 percent of homeless vets are honorably discharged servicemen, and 1/3 served in combat zones during their military career. Post-traumatic stress is a debilitating disorder that plagues military combatants. In an effort of escaping the emotional-

mental trauma associated with war, many veterans are turning to illicit substances (opiates, prescription pain killers, and alcohol).

HFT's SOLUTION

Hope for Tomorrow opened a long-term residential program, specially designed for homeless veterans, called U.S. VETCARE. Due to the communities need for additional services, and the huge success of our U.S. VETCARE program, we are expanding the program to serve an additional 15 homeless vets (23 total).

HOW YOU CAN HELP

We are asking 1,000 people to make a 3-month commitment to help U.S. Veterans that are homeless and struggling with mental health, as well as alcohol & drug addictions. **For the next 3 months, using the attached envelopes, simply mail a tax-deductible contribution to our U.S. VETCARE Program.** So far, we have completed renovations totaling \$125,000: **However, the total project budget is slightly over \$300,000, and we are currently at a standstill until additional dollars are raised. Having said this, our veterans really need your help. If everyone would contribute \$50-\$100/month for the next 3 months, we can continue renovations and 15 homeless veterans (approx. 30 vets a year) will have a safe, substance-free, and supportive place to call "home".**
